Competition organised by Prickwillow Engine Museum during lockdown of the Museum

There are two competition projects available for all the primary school children.

One: to draw a picture of any of our engines or exhibits featured on our website www.prickwillowmuseum.com. The pictures can be in pencil or ink, coloured or painted.

Two: write a poem about drainage, the Fens or the Museum and its engines, using inspiration from our website or any other related articles/websites about the Fens.

The work must be all the children's own work, should have the name and age of the child and the name of the school and class on the back and returned to the school when they are open again for education. The closing date is 30th September 2020, or when schools re-open, whichever is the earliest, and we will arrange for collection from the school (or arrange delivery to the Museum) after this date.

When the Museum is fully open again, hopefully before Easter next year, we will arrange a weekend event to display at least 10 entries from each school, awarding the top 3 in each project from the school with certificates. The best overall entry in each project, from amongst all the schools that enter, judged by an independent judge, will be awarded an art set. Age will be taken into consideration and entries grouped together age appropriately, depending on the age ranges that enter. The number of groups in each project, and therefore the number of prizes, will depend on getting entries in each of the age ranges (5-7; 8-9 and 10-11)
