

Our science topic is plants and it was suggested that you plant some seeds and look after them.

I planted my sunflower seeds on April 14<sup>th</sup>. I planted 12 seeds, but they were two years old so I wasn't sure if they would germinate. I two seeds into each pot, covered them with compost, watered them and put them somewhere sunny and warm. I made sure I watered them regularly. By the 24<sup>th</sup> April, three of them had germinated and two of them had seedling leaves.

I bought some more seeds and planted them on May 2<sup>nd</sup>. When I looked at my seeds yesterday there was no sign of the new ones, but the first plants now have 6 leaves each and are 5cm tall.



I have also had a photo from Seren to show that she has planted her seeds and she has sent a photograph to show that she has now transplanted them outside now that they have got a little bigger and stronger. Seren has obviously been looking after them very well, giving them just the right amount of water and keeping them warm so that they grow strong and healthy.
