Welcome back to the new academic year, and I would like to extend a warm welcome to all of our new parents. I hope you all had an enjoyable summer and are feeling refreshed and ready for the year ahead. The children are all settling well into their new classes and the new Reception children are quickly learning about school routines.

At the beginning of the new school year we ask for your support with the following 2 things:

If your child is having a packed lunch, please ensure that they bring it with them at the start of the day. Increasingly parents are delivering them to the school office later in the morning which causes confusion when dinner registers are taken at 9am.

Also, please ensure dogs and cats are not brought onto the school playground at any time. Thank you for your support with this.

Uniform

Thank you for your support with school uniform - the children are all looking very smart. Please ensure when you are buying new shoes that footwear is appropriate. Trainers should be kept for PE lessons and not worn routinely at other times. Please remember that hair ornaments should be small and in school colours. Jewellery should not be worn, other than watches and stud earrings, which must be removed for PE.

Parent Consultation Evenings

Later this term, there will be an opportunity to discuss your child's progress at Parent Consultation Evenings, dates for which are at the end of the newsletter. For those parents new to the school, the system is that a list of available times is displayed in school in advance of the evenings. Parents are then asked to sign the time they would like against the teacher's name. This term the list will be available from Tuesday 2nd October. Anyone unable to get into school on that day will be able to make an appointment by telephoning the school office **after 9.30am**.

It is always possible to speak to your child's teacher at other times if you need to. The end of the school day is normally the best time to do this as they are busy preparing for lessons before school. If you are worried about something, please do not wait until Consultation Evenings.
